MEETING MINUTES

April 7, 2021

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Tom Englerth called the meeting to order at 8:05 a.m., verified each Board member could hear and be heard by all others and noted that a quorum was present.

COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC

Members of the public were invited to submit comments in advance and were offered opportunity to comment at this time. There were no comments from the public.

CONSENT AGENDA

Chairman Englerth reviewed the consent agenda items: RACY Board Meeting Minutes for March 3, 2021 and RACY Financial Statements for February 2021. On a motion by Mr. Jose Santiago, properly seconded by Mr. Phil Briddell, a vote was conducted by roll call, and the Board approved the consent agenda unanimously as presented.

RESOLUTIONS FOR NEW RACP AWARDS

Mr. Joe Mula made a motion to approve the resolutions of both New Hope Ministries and CASA that was properly seconded by Mr. Briddell. Following a roll call vote, the board approved the resolutions unanimously as presented.

- Currently looking at ways to refine scoring project in order to best use the fund available

Red Lion property is in the beginning stages of being deemed blighted

Dr. Silas Chamberlin shared the following update on the IDA:

• The Yorktowne is continuing construction as well as exploring additional funding opportunities and navigating tax credits

EXECUTIVE SESSION

OTHER BUSINESS

Mr. Briddell shared the following update regarding the sale of the York Wastewater Treatment Plant. The sale was approved 10 days ago but it was contingent on an agreement between city council and the buyer to get the information they need to submit it to the Pennsylvania Utilities Commission. Upon submission, the PUC will have to approve it and from there the city will receive funding.

Dr. Chamberlin shared they are starting to receive feedback from the Army Corp. of Engineers for the Codorus Creek Project. There will be an agenda item regarding the Codorus Creek Project in May.
