Blighted Property Review Committee MEETING MINUTES December 14, 2023

PROJECT UPDATE

Ms. Kim Hogeman, Mr. Bronley Martin, and Mr. David Garbedian shared the following update regarding 333 N Pleasant Dallastown Property:

 The BPRC sent a First Notice of Violation earlier this year and the property owner replied with a timeline and tasks to address the blight. Since the BPRC meeting in October, the property owner did remove some debris and began abatement, but it has been 30 days since any further progress was made. After the holidays, staff will contact the owner regarding plans for further blight remediation.

LERTA PROGRAM UPDATE

Ms. Hogeman and Mr. Martin shared the following information regarding 17-19 S George Street property

A certificate of appropriateness was issued by the City of York's Blighted Property Review Committee for consideration of a LERTA for this property. The property was vacant since 2007 and purchased by the current owner in 2021 who seeks to do renovations to the first-floor retail space and apartments in the upper floors. On a motion by Ms. Cindy Seibel, properly seconded by Mr. John McLucas, a vote was conducted by roll call, and the committee unanimously agreed that the property meets the definition for a deteriorated property.

BPRC will present to the County Commissioners in January to share their recommendations regarding the LERTA process.
